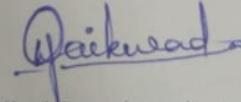
Sub: Participation in Pulse Polio Immunization Programme

Report on Pulse Polio Programme 2019-20

1. Title of the Activity/Event/Practice

Pulse Polio Programme

2. Objectives

- To eliminate polio from the country by providing oral polio vaccine to every child under the age of 5 years.
- To immunize all the children under the age of 5 years.
- To reach children who have missed routine immunization.

3. The Context

The Pulse Polio campaign is a vaccination programme aiming at the elimination of polio. It is a government campaign. As per the schedule, the rural hospital cadets carried out this immunization practice.

4. The Practice

The officials and medical staff from rural hospital, Palghar gave guidance to cadets for carrying out this immunization. As per their instructions, cadets gave an oral dose of polio to children under age 5 years. Cadets went door to door for this campaign and took care that no child left taking polio doses from the locality they had given. On this occasion chief medical officer Dr. Gavit and his medical staff were present.

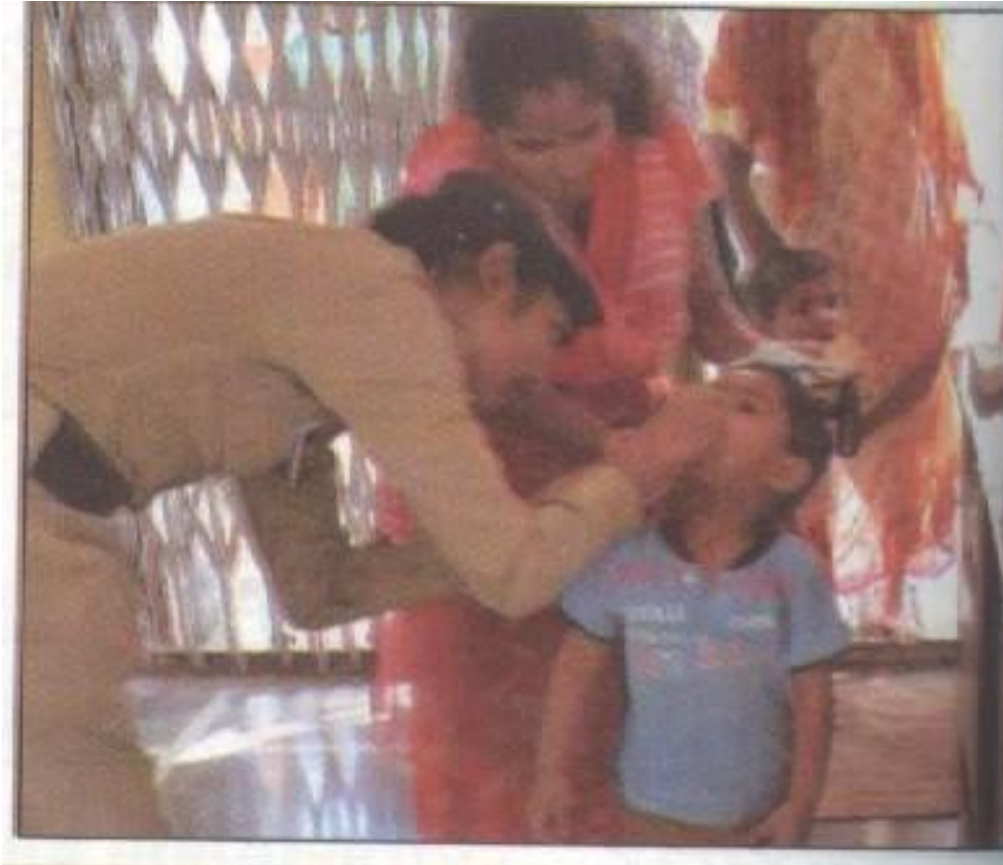
5. Outcome
