MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS AGREEMENT, entered into this **Saturday, 19th September, 2020** by and between **International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD)** and **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar.** (each a "Party" and collectively "the Parties")

The First Party represented herein by its **Dr. Minakshi Gurav** President of **International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD)**

AND

The Second Party represented herein by its **Dr. Kiran Save** Principal of **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar**

WITNESSETH THAT:

WHEREAS, **International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD)** and **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar** desire to enrich their educational opportunities for students and faculty and to advance their pursuit of research and discovery; and

WHEREAS, **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar** desire to serve humanity and community

WHEREAS, **International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD)** and **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar** desire to seek truth, encourage intellectual inquiry and share knowledge; and

WHEREAS, **International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD)** and **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar** desire to strengthen and expand the mutual contacts between the two agencies; and



WHEREAS, **International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD)** and **Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar** desire to provide for a variety of collaborative opportunities for faculty and students on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants and conditions contained in this Agreement and for other valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT

a. Areas of collaboration may be proposed by either institution or may include, but are not limited to:

- i. Joint and articulated workshops
- ii. International study abroad, short- or long-term student exchange.
- iii. Joint teaching, research, or cultural activity.
- iv. Mobility of faculty, scholars, and students between institutions.
- v. Staff professional development.
- vi. Sharing or creation of educational materials and resources.

b. Any specific activity developed under this MOU shall be detailed in a subsequent agreement, signed by each institution's authorized signatory, which will describe the Scope of the proposed activity, intended outcomes, budget, and responsible departments or individuals.

c. All activities shall be subject to the availability of funds and the approval of each institution's authorized representatives.

2. PERIOD OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall be effective upon the date of final execution and will remain in force for a period of one year. Either party may terminate the agreement, with or without cause by providing thirty 30 days students enrolled or engaged in studies at either institution at the time such notice is given, shall be given the opportunity to continue such participation and the Parties shall continue to perform under the terms hereof with regard to the students.



3. ACTIVITIES UNDER THIS AGREEMENT

It is expected that activities taking place under this Agreement will be initiated primarily by academic units within each party, and in coordination with their respective administrative units concerned with all activities. All activities undertaken must conform to the policies and procedures in place at each institution.

4. PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT OF ACTIVITIES

Each distinct collaboration program or activity will be described in a separate Activity Agreement drawn up jointly and signed by authorized signatories of each party. Such agreements will specify the names of those individuals on each campus responsible for the implementation of the program and set forth all terms and conditions associated with the activity. The parties understand that each Activity Agreement may have different circumstances with respect to the personnel, types of activities, intellectual property and other deliverables that either Party may be required to contribute. Therefore, each institute reserves the right to perform a separate risk assessment on the legal, tax and other liabilities that may arise under each Activity Agreement and to structure its deliverables under the Activity Agreement

5. FUNDING OF ACTIVITIES

Activity Agreements should make financial costs and obligations explicit. Collaborating units are encouraged to work together to identify and secure any outside funding which may be needed. Projects requiring funding must be approved by both institutions.

6. NONDISCRIMINATION

International Board for Education, Research and Development (IBERD) and Sonopant Dandekar Arts, V. S. Apte Commerce & M. H. Mehta Science College, Palghar agree that no person shall on the grounds of race, religion, color, sex, age, national origin or ancestry, genetic information, marital status, parental status, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, disability, or status as a veteran be excluded from participation under the terms of this agreement.



7. MODIFICATION

The terms of this Agreement may be changed or modified only by written amendment signed by authorized agents of the parties hereto.

8. CO-ORDINATORS

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for co- ordination and implementation of this agreement.

9. CONFIDENTIALITY:

a) The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the performance of the MoU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

b) The above confidential clause under this MoU excludes the information/data possessed by either Institute before entering into the MoU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

10. SIGNED IN DUPLICATE

This MoU is executed in duplicate with each copy being an official version and having equal validity. By signing below, the Institutes, acting by their duly authorized officers, have caused this Memorandum of Understanding to be executed, effective as of the day and year first above written.
